

Environmental Policy

1. Blakley Electrics Ltd (the company) is a professional and environmentally conscious company, which acknowledges the impact that its operations may potentially have on the environment. The clear objective of Blakley Electrics Ltd is to minimise any impact to the environment by:
 - a) Preventing pollution, reducing waste and ensuring, wherever practicable, that measures are implemented to protect and preserve natural habitats, flora and fauna
 - b) Considering the effects that our operations may have on the local community
 - c) Taking action to eliminate or reduce, as far as practicable, any adverse environmental impacts
 - d) Promoting environmental awareness amongst our suppliers, contractors and partners by implementation of operating procedures
 - e) Seeking to work in partnership with the community by behaving in a considerate and socially responsible manner
2. Managerial and supervisory staff has responsibility for implementation of this policy and must ensure that environmental issues are given adequate consideration. The co-ordination and audit of the company's environmental policy will be undertaken by the Compliance Manager.
3. Blakley Electrics Ltd will fully comply with the duties placed upon it by legislation and regulatory bodies. As part of the company's commitment to maintaining high levels of environmental management, it is the intention that the company will also meet the requirements set out within Approved Guidance documents issued by the Environment Agency and other organisations.
4. All employees and sub-contractors are expected to co-operate and assist in the implementation of this policy, whilst ensuring that their own works, as far as reasonably practicable, are carried out without risk to themselves, others or the environment.
5. Blakley Electrics Ltd will take all practical steps to ensure potential hazards and risks to the environment are identified and that suitable and effective control measures are implemented. All employees will be provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, instruction and training to fulfil the requirements of this policy.
6. The operation of this policy and associated procedures will be reviewed on a regular basis to ensure that they remain applicable to the company's activities. This policy has been endorsed by the board of directors which gives its full support in its implementation.
